### What is the time and cost commitment required?

Acceptance into the competitive duos program means you must attend TWO sessions per week. One session in Cambridge at Riverside Park and one at our courts at Emerald Lake. It is a 12 week program.

### What are the details about the Emerald Lake Beach Tournaments the Scorpions host?

The Scorpions are putting on 6 public youth competitive beach Duos Tournaments this season. *We appreciate it if you attend our independent tournaments as they support the club*. We understand you cannot necessarily attend all of them.

The tournaments are at our beautiful <u>Emerald Lake</u> location. (15 minutes east of Cambridge). We have refurbished all 12 of the back beach courts and three courts near the washrooms with Olympic sand. It is an excellent location. Our tournaments cost \$85 per duo to attend.

This year the Scorpions have also Four 4 on 4 tournaments, 12u-18u. Yes, duos can enter them, though you need to find 4 to have a team. 15U plus ages are co-ed teams.

### My partner cannot make a particular tournament. Can I enter the tournament with another partner?

Yes you can! It can be a lot of fun to enter a tournament with another partner. Sometimes your partner is on holiday or sick and can't make it. A perfect time to get someone else to fill in.

#### What do I bring to a tournament?

- 1.Sun protection umbrella/tent/chairs
- 2.sunscreen
- 3.change of clothes, towels
- 4.healthy foods/snacks
- 5.hydration fluids, water/gatorade (you have to replace the electrolytes and salt lost during the games)
- 6. Yes you can bring a small barbeque.
- 7. Some sort of socks to keep the athletes feet cool when the sand is hot.

### What time do I arrive for a tournament?

Check in is usually between 8:30am-9:00am with games starting shortly after. Do not arrive late. It is a \$10.00 fee per car to park.

#### What are the rules at Emerald Lake?

- No dogs,
- No alcohol,
- Drive slow through the campground,
- Obey the railway crossing guard.

#### Are tournaments cancelled due to weather?

Beach Volleyball is played in all types of weather, except for thunder/lightning. It is not unusual to have heavy rainfalls, hot weather. We will take heat/hydration breaks if necessary. If there is lightning/thunder we will wait the required time before restarting.

### Do we have an end of season beach volleyball bash?

Yes we do an end-of-season party for our competitive duos. It is held at Emerald Lake at the end of the season during a weeknight. It includes free access to the waterpark, hotdogs/hamburgers, awards, and of course beach volleyball.
