

Scorpions Competitive Duos Program 2026 FAQ

Feb. 3/2026 UPDATED

Parents, players in our competitive duos program, here are the answers to some commonly asked questions often asked about the program. Please read the whole document if you are thinking of playing competitive duos for Scorpions.

What are the criteria to be in our Competitive Duos Program in 2026?

The priority is given to youth currently on a competitive/select indoor team. The second priority is youth in our club that have shown strong potential in our development program. The third priority is youth from outside our club who played competitive indoor with another club.

How do I register to be in the Competitive Duos Program?

Current Scorpions Competitive/Select Players has until March 9th to register online to play competitive duos. Then we open it up to non Scorpions club players if there is room.

Each player registers separately, they put down their partner's name.

The link to register is on our Competitive Beach website February 9th, 2026

What is the time and cost commitment required?

Acceptance into the competitive duos program means you must attend TWO sessions per week. One session in Cambridge at Riverside Park and one at our courts at Emerald Lake. It is a 12-week program. Training starts the week of May 12th, 2026.

The COST for each athlete for 2026 to be in the program is \$305.00.

We know some will miss a week if they are on vacation, but it is important to commit to attending training as there are usually more athletes interested than spots available in our program.

What is Commit to Beach Weekend May 9th and 10th, 2026 and what does it have to do with the Competitive Beach Duos Program?

We are hosting our 11th year of this orientation program. It has become an essential part of our competitive duos program for all NEW duo's to get a hands on, practice 2-day training session at Emerald Lake before the season starts. Can parents attend practices at Emerald Lake and Riverside Park?

The practices at Emerald Lake and Riverside Park are open to parents, However, at Emerald Lake we want to minimise traffic during the week, we suggest people take turns carpooling there. At Riverside Park sand courts and Emerald Lake, parents bring a chair to sit on.

What are the details about the Emerald Lake Beach Tournaments the Scorpions host?

The Scorpions are putting on 6 public youth competitive beach Duos Tournaments this season. *We appreciate it if you attend our independent tournaments as they support the club.* We understand you cannot necessarily attend all of them.

Our tournaments are at our beautiful [Emerald Lake](#) location. (15 minutes east of Cambridge). Our tournaments cost \$86 per duo to attend. There is \$15. Per car to enter Emerald Lake.

The Ontario Volleyball Association also puts on Duo's tournaments, how can I sign up for them?

My partner cannot make a particular tournament. Can I enter the tournament with another partner?

Yes, you can! It can be a lot of fun to enter a tournament with another partner. Sometimes your partner is on holiday or sick and can't make it. A perfect time to get someone else to fill in.

What do I bring to a tournament?

1. Sun protection umbrella/tent/chairs
2. sunscreen
3. change of clothes, towels
4. healthy foods/snacks
5. hydration fluids, - water/gatorade (*you have to replace the electrolytes and salt lost during the games*)
6. Yes, you can bring a small barbeque.
7. Some sort of socks to keep the athletes' feet cool when the sand is hot. (We sell sand socks at beginning of the season)

What time do I arrive for a tournament?

Check in is usually between 8:30am-9:00am with games starting shortly after. Do not arrive late. It is a \$10.00 fee per car to park.

What are the rules at Emerald Lake?

- No dogs,
- No alcohol,
- Drive slow through the campground,
- Obey the railway crossing guard.

Are tournaments cancelled due to weather?

Beach Volleyball is played in all types of weather, except for thunder/lightning. It is not unusual to have heavy rainfalls, hot weather. We will take heat/hydration breaks

if necessary. If there is lightning/thunder, we will wait the required time before restarting.

Do we have an end of season beach volleyball bash?

At the last practice will have free access to the waterpark and an earlier start time. The club pays for the use of the waterpark.
